## Big Fish Story Shark Instructions

1. Select a box that will fit $5 \times 9$ inch image of the shark (e.g., long and narrow tissue box, small shoe box).
2. Cover entire box in black duct tape -If using a tissue box, do not cover the tissue hole. -If using a box, cut a round hole in the center of one side of the box, approximately 2.5 inches in diameter.

- *Note: If you do not have black duct tape, you can opt for covering the box in any color or decoration you prefer.


3. Print and laminate shark image. Printing the shark on card stock is recommended due to its durability.
4. Cut around the image of the shark to fit the surface area of the side of the box you are using. Then, cut out the shark's mouth, including the spaces around the teeth.

5. Tape the shark image to the black box with the shark's mouth on top of the hole in the box.
